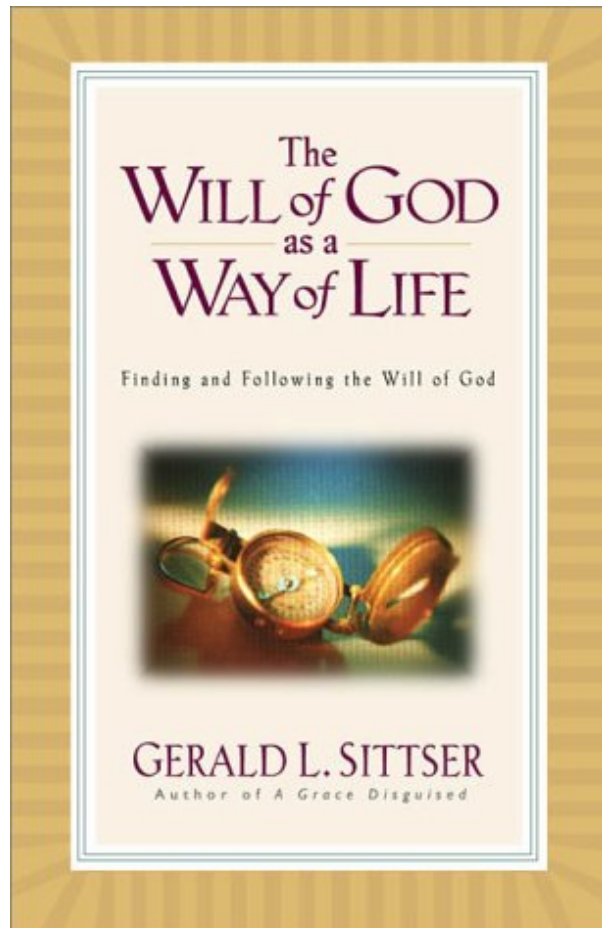

The outstanding feature of this book is the author's honesty about exploring and doing the will of God; an exploration marked by intense pain and heart-searching questions.
